From **MB & F**, this **Horological Machine No. 1** (\$149,000) offers hour and minutes on separate dials with a raised one-minute tourbillon between them. This **Instinct Tourbillon** (\$53,550) from **Rodolphe** is crafted in 18k rose gold and houses a mechanical movement with 60 hours of power reserve and retrograde date readout.
